

Patagonia Trout Chalhuequen Trip

Here is our schedule for your trip for the following dates, Saturday February 10th until Saturday February 17th.

Arrival to Esquel Airport and transfer to Chalhuequen Lodge in Los Cipreses

After unpacking we will spend the rest of the afternoon on a tour through a local vineyard and winery, where you will do a wine tasting.



Day 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7th: Fishing the area of Rio Grande, Los Alerces National Park, Corcovado and Arroyo Pescado Spring Creek

Day 8, Saturday, Jan. 6th: Transfer to the airport

Breakfast, finishing packing and the rest of the morning off. After Lunch we will arrive at the airport for the check-in.

Fishing Area -Some of the places we can fish within the Lodge's vicinity are:

- - Rio Grande (Futaleufú) The lodge is located on the banks of this big and slow meandering river (on the Argentinian side) that flows from the Futaleufú dam into Chile and all the way to the Pacific Ocean. After the border it drops into several class V canyons to be known as one the white water Mekas. Especially good for small dry flies on its back eddies, nymphing its rifles and swinging streamers in its deeper areas. We have 3 different sections for one day float trips. Depending on the float in some of them you may start or finish your day at the lodge's doorstep.
- - Arroyo Pescado Spring Creek. Famous for its grasshoppers hatches, this spring creek flows into the Tecka River. We access the spring creek through the Arroyo Pescado estancia, this is a private access fishery, only wading is allowed.
- - Futalaufquen Lake
- - Desaguadero River (wading)
- - Laguna Larga Lake



- - Arrayanes River and the reed banks of Lago Verde. In the heart of Los Alerces National Park, the Arrayanes river connects the waters of Lago Verde and Rio Menendez with Futalaufquen Lake. This river is great for dry fly fishing and nymphing its vast pools. Lago Verde is especially good in the summer months for dry fly fishing on its reeds and cliffs.
- - Rivadavia River. World-famous river for its gin clear water and challenging fishing. It's known as "The university of Fly fishing". You will enjoy every corner of this float with its stunning views and the possibility of catching huge trout on dry fly or nymphing.
- - Rio Corcovado. Born at the Vintter Lake, this river alternates slow meandering bends and canyons with heavy white water. It flows through Estancia Tecka and after that it becomes a freestone river with some class III rapids. Good for pocket dry fly fishing and for streamers as well. (We have 2 different sections for one day float trips).
- - Rio percy
- - Nant y Fall creek
