## FISH FACTS

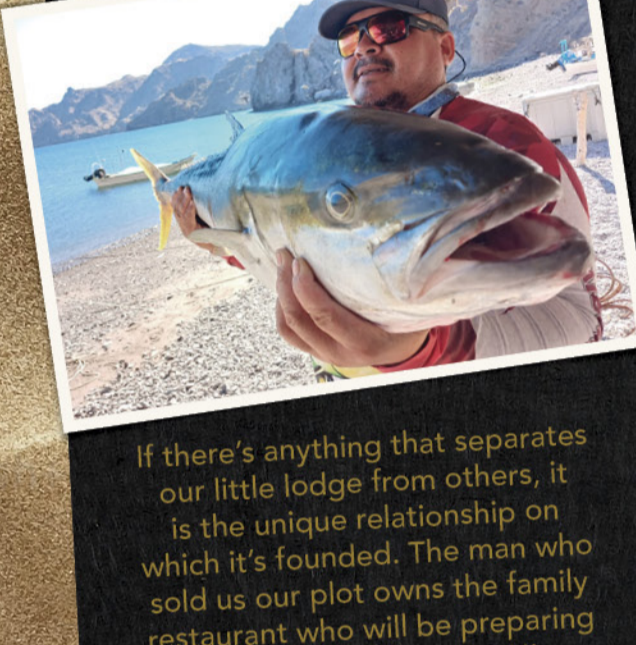
- we've had more days of "catching" than "fishing"
- doubles on roosterfish in the 10-25 pound class have been commonplace
- numerous shots, hookups, break-offs, and blown chances at fish in a class above the above—like, the size of a German Shepherd!

- most days we never see another panga
- the unique geographical location provides ample protection from prevailing winds
- the variety of game fish is extensive: numerous dorado, big crevalle jack, colorful snapper, and hard-fighting tuna species, just to name a few ...

- many, if not most, of these fish have never seen a fly
- seasonally, the yellowtail fishing is world-class (we couldn't help ourselves ;)
- we're just scratching the surface

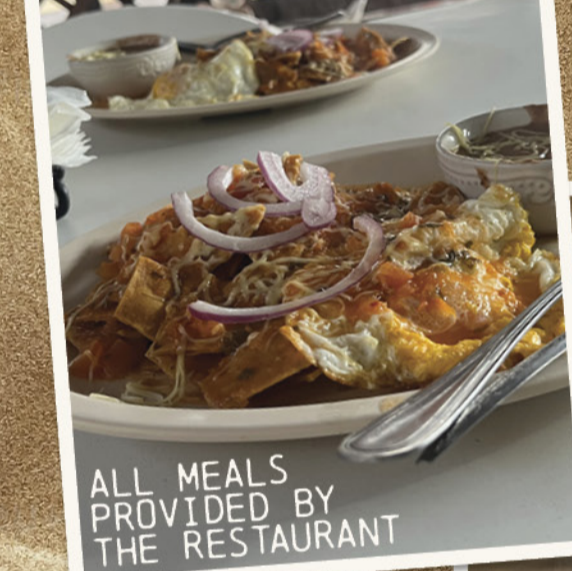


RECOMMENDED SETUP FOR ROOSTERFISH, DORADO, & JACKS  
10-12 WT SALTWATER ROD W/ MATCHING HIGH QUALITY REEL • REEL EQUIPPED WITH A MINIMUM 250 YARDS OF 65# GEL SPUN BACKING • FLY LINES WE LOVE: RIO TROPICAL OUTBOUND SHORT CLEAR INTERMEDIATE OR SA SONAR TITAN CLEAR TIP • WE RECOMMEND "NAIL KNOTTING" THE WELDED LOOPS ON YOUR FLY LINES

RECOMMENDED SETUP FOR TUNA, AMBERJACK, GROUPEL AND OTHER DEEPER WATER SPECIES  
12 WT ROD • WE LOVE THE RIO LEVIATHAN LINE FOR OUR DEEPER WATER SPECIES • YELLOWFIN TUNA ARE EXTREMELY HARD FIGHTING AND TAKE A LOT OF LINE • WE RECOMMEND EXTREMELY WELL BUILT REELS WITH A MINIMUM OF 300 YARDS OF 65# GEL SPUN BACKING

## THE HONEST ANGLER'S BAJA ITINERARY

## TRIP OUTLINE

Fly in Sat/Sun (depending on personal preference and available flight times)

**SUNDAY**  
(If flying into Cabo): Meet pre-arranged transport services for ride to La Paz. Enjoy a Pacifico en route! Meet our local host for a welcome dinner and orientation at Hotel Catedral, our preferred lodging while you're in La Paz @ 6 PM

**MONDAY**  

- Roll out for the lodge, early morning
- Meet boats for a full day of fishing
- Return & relax
- Enjoy one of the optional afternoon adventures available: swimming, snorkeling, beach fishing, halapa, or settle in with a good book under the rooftop palapa
- Meet for dinner at the local restaurant (Your catch might be on the menu!)
- Meander back to the lodge and share a nightcap—and one last fishing tale—before a solid night's rest

**TUESDAY-THURSDAY**  
Full day of fishing  
Etc,etc,etc )

**FRIDAY**  
Full day of fishing  
Return to La Paz in the afternoon for tentative arrival to Hotel Catedral by 6 PM

**SATURDAY**  
Return to Cabo airport (via pre-arranged transport) or La Paz airport for air travel home

## WHERE TO FLY

Guests have two main options for air travel—San Jose Del Cabo (SJD) or La Paz International (LPZ). Flights into Cabo are more numerous and typically far less expensive. La Paz has the advantage of being more direct, as it's our "launch" point for the trek out to the lodge and our return point, after fishing is completed on Friday. Excellent and comfortable transport services Cabo to/from La Paz are included in the price of your trip with us.



## ABOUT THE LODGE



Currently under construction, our Casa is designed to be a cozy but well-appointed beachfront home that features two dual-occupancy guest bedrooms, as well as a master suite. There are two full bathrooms, with a powder bath in the common area, and a full kitchen. A spacious rooftop patio with shade structure is also in the works. The lodge will be equipped with modern amenities, such as air conditioning, filtered water, hot showers, Starlink WIFI, and a full solar array.
